

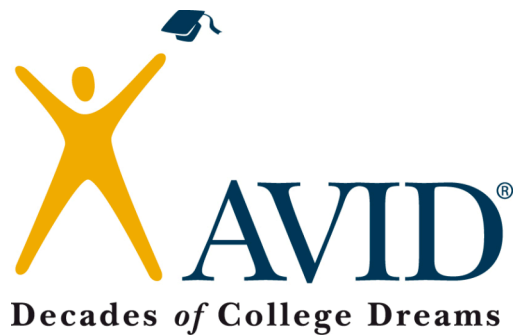
AVID Mission

What is the AVID Student Profile?

“The AVID Student Profile describes ‘students in the middle’ as students with academic potential, average to high test scores, 2.0-3.5 GPA, college potential with support, desire and determination to go to college, and one who meets one or more of the following criteria: first in family to attend college, historically underserved in 4-year colleges, low income, special circumstances. The AVID student is one who can achieve in rigorous curriculum with approximately one hour of extra support per day.”

9th Grade Program (Mr. Edde)

Students are enrolled in Honors English alternating with AVID on an A/B day schedule for the entire year. Mr. Edde is looking forward to having an eager group of ninth graders joining the program.

10th Grade Program (Mr. Gasiorowski)

The AVID 10 students will be enrolled in Honors Civics & Economics/AVID 10 course which will be on an A/B day schedule for the year.

11th Grade Program (Mr. Tarr)
